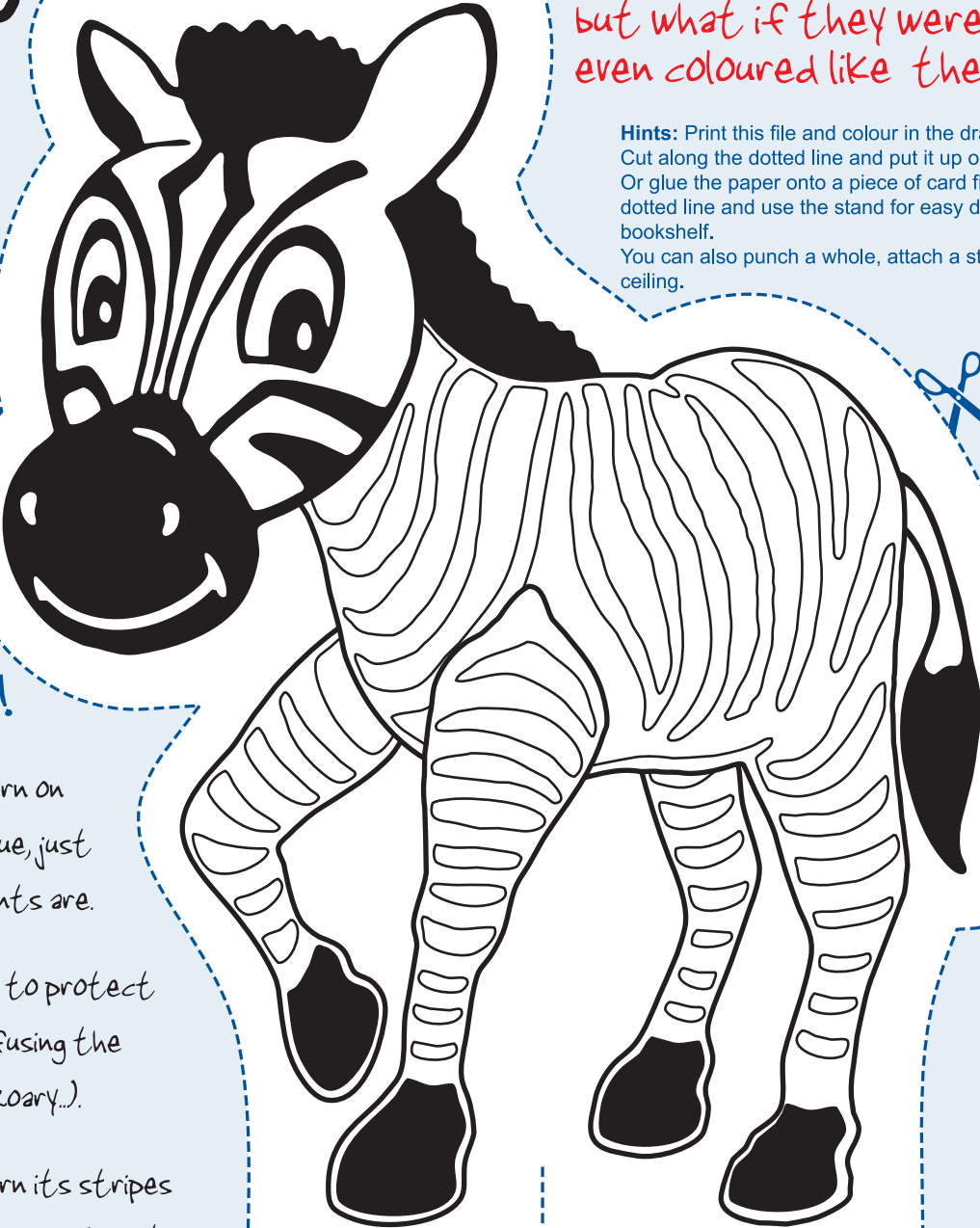

Zebra usually have black stripes but what if they were red, blue or even coloured like the rainbow?

Hints: Print this file and colour in the drawing.

Cut along the dotted line and put it up on your wall or window. Or glue the paper onto a piece of card first, then cut along the dotted line and use the stand for easy display on a desk or bookshelf.

You can also punch a hole, attach a string and hang it from the ceiling.



Did you know?!

The stripe pattern on each zebra is unique, just like your fingerprints are.

The stripes help to protect the zebra by confusing the predators (poor Roary..).

When a zebra is born its stripes are brown. As they grow older the stripes become black.

Zebra sleep standing up.

Never use scissors without adults around!
